DAY ONE

Employers and Universities

Sessions, training and workshops will be run by employers and universities to share best practice on connecting returnee students back home. Below is an outline of the sessions provided for universities:

MORNING SESSION

In this immersive and interactive professional development session, you will gain on-the-ground insight from local and international graduate program experts in areas including:

- A background of the China, Hong Kong and SEA labour markets (cultural, economic, history)

Region-specific graduate salary trends and data

- Understanding of main industries and sectors seeking graduate talent – Banking & Finance, Media & Communications, Government and Start-ups.

- Insight to best-practice graduate program strategy and timelines across the China, Hong Kong and SEA regions.

- Regional comparisons between candidate assessment, development and methodology – including key differences between USA, UK, Australia and the Asian regions.





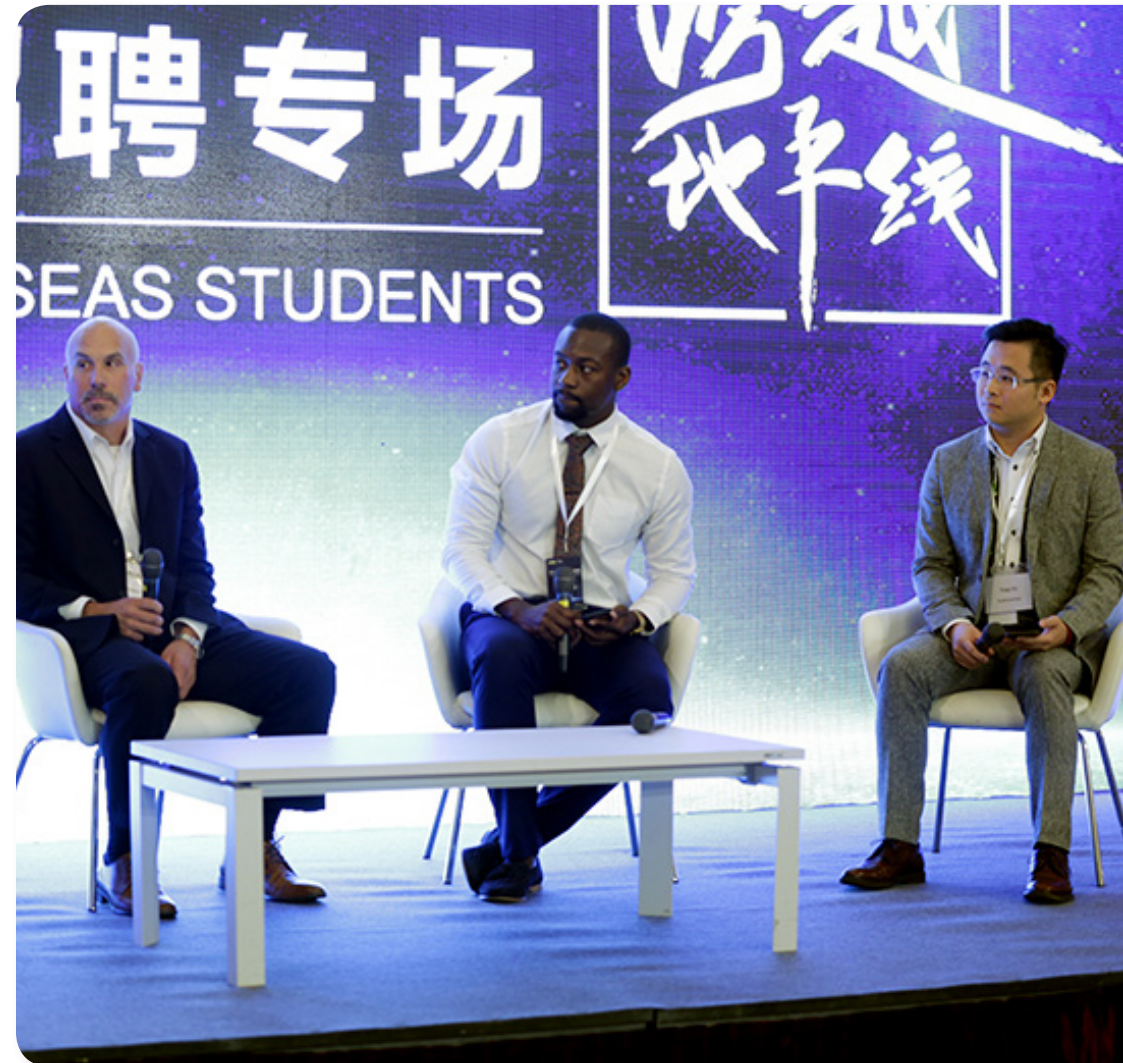
The structure of the session will include:

- Market insight quiz – what do you know about the China, Hong Kong and SEA regions when it comes to how and why employers in these regions recruit graduate talent?
- Comparison of graduate recruitment and development process – when compared to your home region. An understanding of how to better prepare your international students who are returning back to these 'home' regions to work.
- Networking with like-minded careers professionals to share experiences, initiatives and experiences when it comes to managing international students from these regions.

AFTERNOON SESSION
